If you are a UK taxpayer and have, at any time, signed a Gift Aid declaration form for the parish, could you please confirm this with either Christine Hunter or David Mackey.



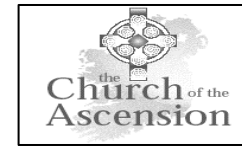
